Rules for Recycling: Please make sure that all recycling is clean and dry. Recycling should not be bagged; please remove recycling from garbage bags when disposing. Please only recycle what is listed below as accepted to avoid recycling contamination.

Accepted Items: The Blount County Recycling Center has four recycling bins and accepts the following items:

Single-Stream Recycling Bin

- Mixed paper (including junk mail, magazines, office paper, phone books, paper bags, paperboard packaging)
- Aluminum and steel cans
- Plastic #1 and #2

Newspaper Bin- Newspaper only

Corrugated Cardboard Bin- Corrugated cardboard (including moving boxes and packing boxes)

Glass bin- Any color glass. Please remove lids and caps.

Unaccepted items:

- Food waste or food-soiled packaging
- Plastic utensils, straws, and takeout containers
- Plastic film, bags, wrap, or bubble wrap
- Plastics #3-#7
- Food wrappers (mylar)
- Aluminum foil or pans
- Waxed cartons, cups, and containers
- Styrofoam
- Sheet metal
- Tires
- Yard Waste
- Household Hazardous Waste, electronics, lightbulbs, and batteries
